Important Note:

Because of staffing issues aggravated by US immigration policy our host, Skylake Yosemite Camp, cannot offer UUCPA exclusive use of their campgrounds for a weekend in 2018. As a result, we will need to share the campgrounds with other Skylake Yosemite Family camp registrants

Cabins Available in 2018: Sequoia, Sugar Pine, Toyon, Alder, Lodgepole, Juniper, Larkspur, Clover, Chinquapin, Maple, Cedar, Lupine, Manzanita, Oak, Ponderosa, Red Fir, White Pine, Karok, Pomo and Ohlone. **Cabins will be reserved in the order that registrations are received.**

CAMP ACCOMMODATIONS

Rustic screened cabins sleep up to eight people—each cabin has four bunk beds. A single bed and mattress is provided for each camper. You bring your own sleeping bag or linens. Bathhouses have sinks, showers, toilets, electricity and lights, but cabins do not. Weather is typically warm in the daytime, but temperatures can dip to 50 degrees in the evening. Dress is very casual.

FOOD AND DRINK

Eight delicious meals are included in your registration fee, beginning with breakfast on Friday morning. Most lunches and dinners include a salad bar, and vegetarian options are available at every meal. You can pack a sack lunch if you will be out of camp at lunchtime. The camp is unable to accommodate special diets, so you will need to provide for food allergies or other dietary needs.

On Friday and Saturday evenings immediately before dinner is Social Hour on the outdoor deck of the main hall. Appetizers are served by the camp staff and augmented by the campers, who bring snacks and beverages to share.

ACTIVITIES

Select your own activities at your own pace—hike, swim, canoe, water ski, kayak, do arts and crafts, archery, read, snooze, play volleyball, basketball, tennis or tether ball. One horseback ride is included with your registration (ages 6 and up). Water skiing and boat rides are available for an extra fee. The south end of Yosemite Park is approximately 45 minutes away.

In the evenings the camp offers a campfire program, including marshmallows roasted over the coals. Bring songs, jokes and poetry to share. Back in the main hall, we play cards or other games, read, knit, work on jigsaw puzzles, play ping pong or foosball. Some venture down to the dock to stargaze.

FEES & REGISTRATION

The fee includes three nights of lodging, eight meals and one horseback ride for ages 6 and up.

- For cabins with three or more people, the fee is per person.
- For cabins with fewer than 2 adults and two children ages 6 to 12, the fee is the minimum cabin fee.

Early Bird Registration – Pay in Full by February 28th

Age 13 and up: \$255 Age 6 to 12: \$155 5 and younger free Minimum cabin fee: \$665

<u>Full Fee Registration</u> – March 1st to August 1st

Age 13 and up: \$275 Age 6 to 12: \$175 5 and younger free Minimum cabin fee: \$725

A cabin is reserved based upon receipt of completed forms and full payment in the UUCPA office. In 2018 UUCPA Camp will be sharing the campground with other Family camp registrants and not all cabins will be available. If you are willing to share a cabin, please indicate this on the registration form
