### How To Make the No-Rehearsal Christmas Pageant Costumes

This PDF contains:

- 1 sheep mask to print and cut out
- instructions to make a shepherd's head scarf
- 1 cardboard crown to print, color, and cut out
- 5 cardboard animal head bands to print, color and cut out

## 1. How to make the sheep mask:

- 1. Print the mask on paper or cardstock.
- 2. Cut carefully along the outside line.

3. To make the handle stiff, fold along the dotted lines.

## 2. How to make a shepherd's head scarf:

Take a pillow case, or any piece of cloth about that size. Drape it over your head. Here's Elephant with a head scarf:



## 3. How to make the animal ears:

- 1. Print the ears on paper or cardstock.
- 2. Color in the ears.
- 3. Cut along the heavy solid lines.
- 4. Fold the ears so they stand up.
- 5. If you want, color in the head band.
- 6. Put the head band on your head.

# 4. How to make the Wise Person's crown:

1. Color in both halves of the crown.

2. Cut out both halves of the crown.

3. Tape both halves together together to make one big crown.


It will work best if you put tape BOTH ON THE INSIDE, AND ON THE OUTSIDE. Tape does not stick very well to crayon, so you might want to color in the crown with markers.


## How To Use These in the Pageant:


Come in person, or join on Zoom. Bring your head scarf, and your completed animals ears, mask, and crown.

During the pageant, when the ministers ask for sheep, hold up your sheep mask. (If you're on Zoom, make sure your camera is turned on.)

Then when they ask for shepherds, put on your shepherd's head scarf. Or when they ask for animals in the stable, put on some animal ears. And when they ask for Wise People, put on your crown.
